

# LIVING THE REVOLUTION

**Following Jesus is radical.** Jesus died. Jesus rose again. And those that follow Jesus are to be radically changed by that good news... it will start a **REVOLUTION** in your life.

We're going to look at a biography of Jesus – written by Luke – and ask the questions: What makes Jesus so radical? What does it mean to live the revolution? **Are you living it?**

**(1) RADICAL LOVE** Luke 15:11-35 God loves you with a radical love. No matter what stupid things you've done or how good you think you are – Jesus came to show God's love to you.

**(2) RADICAL KING** Luke 23:32-43 Christianity is all about King Jesus. You need to realise that you aren't the king, but that Jesus who died on the cross is THE King.

**(3) RADICAL DISCIPLINE** Luke 9:18-27 A disciple is a follower. Jesus' followers are called to radical discipleship. It involves denying yourself, taking up your cross and following Jesus.

**(4) RADICAL CHANGE** Luke 19:1-10 Following Jesus means you will be different. You will be different in how you use money, pursue sex + relationships, say sorry, serve others and live for something other than yourself.

**(5) RADICAL PRIORITIES** - Luke 16:1-15 - In this final study, Jesus says something shocking: "You should use your money to buy friends." No joke. What does this mean? Get ready for Jesus to change your priorities!
